Inauguration of ‘The Human Cost of Terrorism’ exhibition

External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar inaugurated the exhibition titled “The Human Cost of Terrorism” on June 30 at the United Nations in New York. The exhibition, organized by the Permanent Mission of India, will run from June 30 to July 11, 2025.

2. Speaking on the occasion, the External Affairs Minister underlined that terrorists should have no impunity and they are not to be treated as proxies. Terrorism anywhere is a threat to peace everywhere and State sponsorship of terrorism must be exposed and countered. Further, there should be no yielding to nuclear blackmail.

3. The aim of the exhibition is to shed light on the profound and often overlooked impact of terrorism on individuals, families, and communities worldwide. Through a curated selection of photographs, multimedia presentations, and testimonial displays, the exhibition will showcase the human cost of terrorism and its impact around the world.

4. It will also highlight a diverse range of national and international efforts aimed at preventing and countering terrorism in all its forms and manifestations, while highlighting achievements and ongoing challenges in the global counter-terrorism landscape.

5. The exhibition will remain open for viewing at two locations: Delegates Entrance – June 30 to July 3; and Vienna Café – July 7 to July 11.
